PACKING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Label all clothing and personal belongings with name.
- Pack in suitcases, no trunks.
- Campers will unpack into cubbyholes and store soft luggage under their bed, so do not send valuable or unneeded items.
- All bunks are twin. One blanket is plenty: the sleeping bag can be another blanket.
- For safety, no nose hoops, septum piercings or other facial piercings, ear gauges or earring hoops bigger than a dime. Bigger earrings may be worn for costume events and Special Dinner.
- Sporty one-piece swimsuits are required for girls. Boys wear swim trunks rather than briefs.
