**Other possibilities:** Sunscreen; bug repellent (aerosols may be kept in the infirmary); flip-flops; camera; battery operated personal fan; activity/coloring/reading books for Rest Hour; pens or pencils; three or four stamped, home-addressed envelopes/paper or postcards; hat with brim; 100% cotton pre-washed something white if you take a tie-dye activity; fishing tackle; shower caddy

### PACKING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Label all clothing and personal belongings with name.
- Pack in suitcases; no trunks.
- Campers will unpack into cubbyholes and store soft luggage under their bed, so do not send valuable or unneeded items.
- All bunks are twin. Two-week campers must sleep in a set of twin sheets, not in their sleeping bag. One blanket is plenty: the sleeping bag can be another blanket.
- For safety, no nose hoops, septum piercings, other facial piercings, ear gauges or earrings hoops bigger than a dime. Bigger earrings may be worn for costume events and Special Dinner.
- Sporty one-piece swimsuits are required for girls. Boys wear swim trunks rather than briefs.
